Introduction

This study is a survey of all the messianic prophecies in the Hebrew Scriptures which were fulfilled at the First Coming of Messiah. The Orthodox Jewish interpretation does not, of course, expect Messiah to come twice, but rather – as will be seen later – expects two Messiahs, each coming once. This study is presented from a Messianic Jewish perspective. The Scriptures we will analyze are the *Torah* (the Law), the *Neviim* (the Prophets), and the *K'tuvim* (the Writings).
